

1. Metrics Matter III: Counting Local

Comparison of local funding proportions across the sampled countries using Publish What You Fund's measurement approach for five OECD DAC donors



- ► Low proportion of direct funding channelled to local organisations only 5.5%.
- Inconsistent measurement approaches in tracking local funding.
